

Patrick McNeill Memorial Scholarship

As a volunteer during the early years of the credit union, Pat McNeill dedicated his time and energy to serve others. Pat was responsible for making loans and for many of those years, the credit union had no office; Pat's briefcase <u>was</u> the credit union. Pat was an original Director of the credit union in 1969 and served on the Board of Directors for 12 years, three as Chairman. Mr. McNeill will forever be remembered for fulfilling the credit union's mission of "People Helping People."

The Award

Ocean Financial Federal Credit Union's Patrick McNeill Memorial Scholarship provides four \$2,000 scholarships and two \$500 scholarships that are paid directly to each recipient's college.

<u>Eligibility</u>

To qualify as an eligible applicant, you must be a member in good standing at Ocean Financial Federal Credit Union and meet the following criteria:

- 1. You must be a college-bound high school senior when your application is submitted.
- 2. You must be a first-time college student who will be attending an accredited two- or four-year institution of higher education in the Fall 2022.
- 3. You must be the primary owner of an Ocean Financial account (a Youth Savings Account or a Regular Share Account).

Scholarship funds are made payable directly to the college.

PLEASE NOTE: Family members of all Ocean Financial Federal Credit Union employees, Directors and Committee Members are NOT eligible for the Patrick McNeill Memorial Scholarship.

Application Process

Eligible members must complete the attached application. Please type or print clearly. Eligible member and a parent/guardian **must** sign the Certification and Release Authorization at the end of the application.

Selection Process

Judging will be based on subjective and objective criteria. All information provided is subject to investigation and verification by Ocean Financial Federal Credit Union.

Application Deadline

The application and essay must be returned to the credit union by Monday, January 31, 2022. If any portion of this application is incomplete or the applicant is not the primary on an Ocean Financial account, the application <u>will not</u> be considered.

How to Submit Your Application
